Minutes of the Committee Meeting of LAC held on 3rd Apr 2002 at SALSAL, Worples Road, Laleham.
The meeting was called to order by the acting Chairman, Keith Smith, at 2015 hrs.

Minutes of Previous Meeting

- Minutes of the Committee Meeting of 6th Mar 2002 were read and agreed.

Matters Arising From The Minutes

- The new waterproof faces, to be trialled on the permanent outside bosses this summer, are no longer available having been withdrawn by FITA.
- New keys for the equipment shed can be purchased for £6 in a shop in Windsor.
- A recent clear out has identified sufficient equipment for the Opening Shoot.
- The Secretary will follow up the details of the possible source of van hire he identified (**Action by AW**).
- The Secretary will follow upon the outcome of the Spelthorne Sports Council Grant application (**Action by AW**).
- Follow up on the names of people interested in archery from the Royal Egham Show can now place after the list of names was found in the Treasurers briefcase (**Action by AW**).

Chairman's Report:

- No Chairman, so no report.

Secretary's Report:

- After a discussion the Committee decided to vote against the proposal from GNAS to increase affiliation fees for all Archers by a significant proportion above current inflation levels (**Action by AW**).
- The Club has received the latest version of the SCAS Directory and Reports.
- The Club still awaits the outcome of the application for a grant to buy Beginners Equipment using funds from Spelthorne Sports Council after the Secretary was unable to attend the meeting (**Action by AW**).
- A report on the results of the BA Postal League was given to the meeting with the Recurve 'A' and Compound Frostbite teams coming closest to success. Full results to be put on the Notice Board and on the website (**Action by AW**). The organization of the Clubs entry into next winters League is now the responsibility of the Match Officer.
- The Club has approved applications for Associate Membership from John Pearce from Bucks AA. George and Eileen Potts from Spelthorne Archers have also indicated their intention to apply for Associate Membership in the near future.
- Current Membership of the Club stands at 1 Honorary Life Member, 32 Seniors (27 Gents and 5 Ladies), 10 Juniors (7 Boys and 3 Girls) and 1 Associate Member, a total of 44 Members. An additional 8 existing Members have also expressed their intention to renew their subs and this, together with 2 new joiners and (potentially a maximum of) 3 Associate Members, is expected to push the total to 57 Members level. A further 7 existing Members have not yet renewed although they have all (except one) paid their current GNAS subscriptions.
- The Secretary will phone the new Manager of SALSAL, Adrian Davies, with regard to getting the permanent whitewashed Shooting Line painted onto the field in time for the Opening Shoot (**Action by AW**).

- A discussion about purchasing and using an old golf cart to pull the target trolley across the field was held, but no conclusions were reached.

Training Officer's Report:

- The dates for the first Beginners Course will be Friday 24th May – Friday 31st May, with a possible second course scheduled for Friday 2nd Aug – Friday 9th August. These dates will be advertised in the Spelthorne Leisure Magazine and on the Spelthorne Website (**Action by SE**).
- A discussion was held as to whether the Club should/could charge a nominal fee to recent beginners to hire equipment from the Club after Beginners Courses.

Record Officer's Report:

- The Handicaps for the new Outdoor Season will be put onto the Notice board in the storage garage in time for the Opening Shoot (**Action by AW**).

Junior Officer's Report:

- Not present, so no report.

Albion Report:

- The Club has already received 3 requests for entry forms for this years Albion.
- No progress had been made with the two Albion Trophies that need to be replaced and two new ones that need to be bought for the Longbow archers attending the Tournament (**Action by AW**).
- No progress had been made with the 40th Anniversary Badge which will be given to all those helping/attending the Laleham Albion in this, its 40th year (**Action by AW**).

Social Organizer's Report:

- A meal has been organized for Sat 27th Apr, price £12 per head.
- A Skittles evening has been organized for Sat 25th May, price £9 or £10 per head.
- A float of £80 was given for the Opening Shoot (**Action by TB**).

Match Officer's Report:
